



When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to Samaria. <sup>15</sup> When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, <sup>16</sup> because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>17</sup> Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.



# Acts 8:14-17

- → Regeneration comes from the Holy Spirit.
- → Baptism is a choice, the Holy Spirit is a gift.
- → They verified by the Apostles, we verify by the word of God.
- → Full knowledge doesn't happen at conversion.

→ HEART REVEALED

When Simon saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money 19 and said, "Give me also this ability so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit."

→ SIN EXPOSED




Then Simon answered, "Pray to the Lord for me so that nothing you have said may happen to me."




After they had further proclaimed the word of the Lord and testified about Jesus, Peter and John returned to Jerusalem, preaching the gospel in many Samaritan villages.
