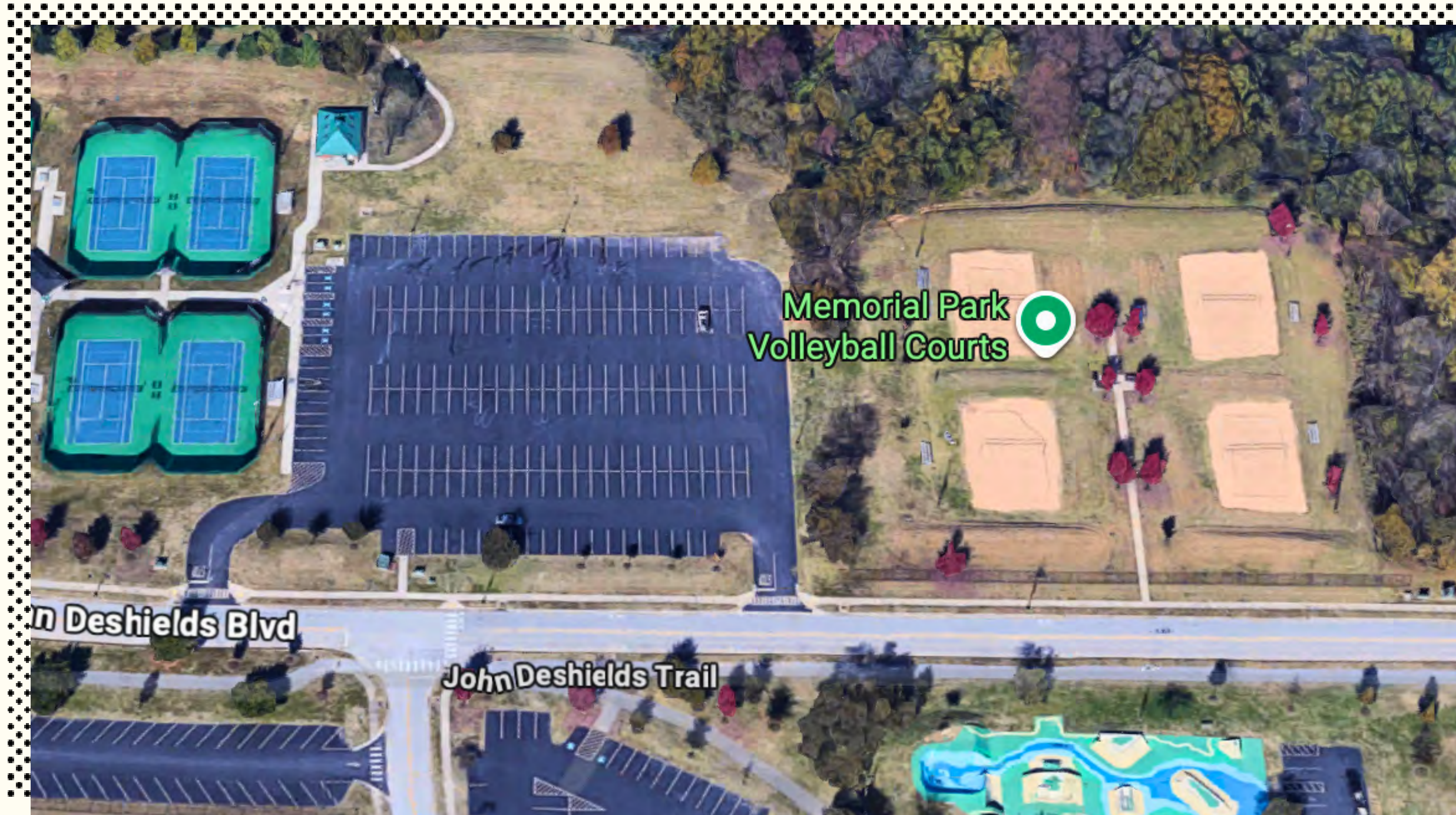

When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to Samaria. ¹⁵ When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, ¹⁶ because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ¹⁷ Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

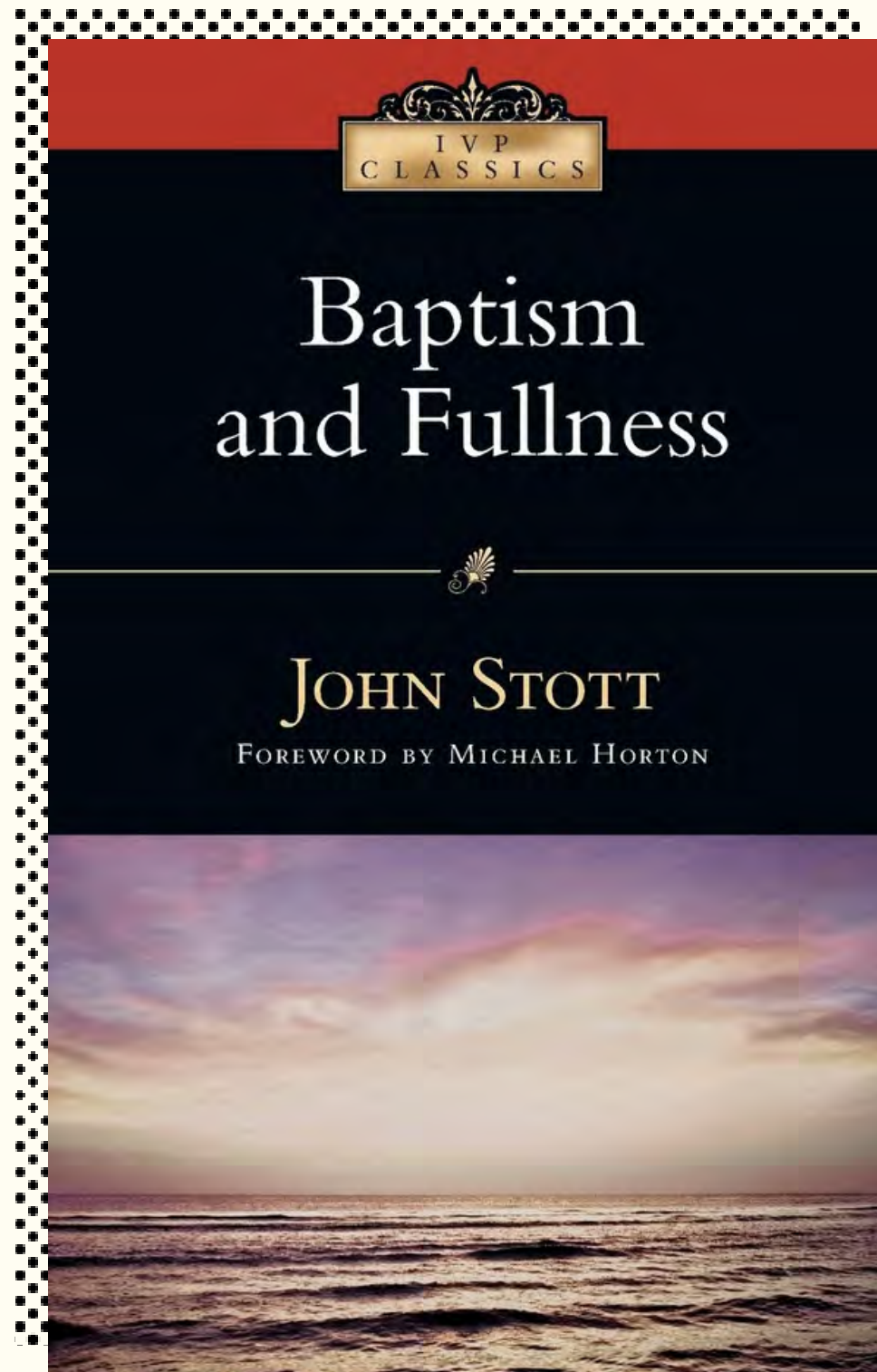

“The most probable answer (to this abnormal situation) is not just that this was the first time the gospel had been preached outside Jerusalem, but that these converts were Samaritans...

And since this historical situation cannot be repeated, I cannot see how the abnormality in the Samaritan reception of the Spirit could be taken as precedent for us today.”

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- UNDERSTANDING -

Acts 8:14-17

- Regeneration comes from the Holy Spirit.
- Baptism is a choice, the Holy Spirit is a gift.
- They verified by the Apostles, we verify by the word of God.
- Full knowledge doesn't happen at conversion.

When Simon saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, **he offered them money**¹⁹ and said, "Give me also this ability so that **everyone on whom I lay my hands** may receive the Holy Spirit."

Peter answered: “**May your money perish with you**, because you thought you could buy the gift of God with money! ²¹ You have no part or share in this ministry, because **your heart is not right before God.** ²² **Repent** of this wickedness and pray to the Lord in the hope that he may forgive you for having such a thought in your heart. ²³ For I see that **you are full of bitterness and captive to sin.**”

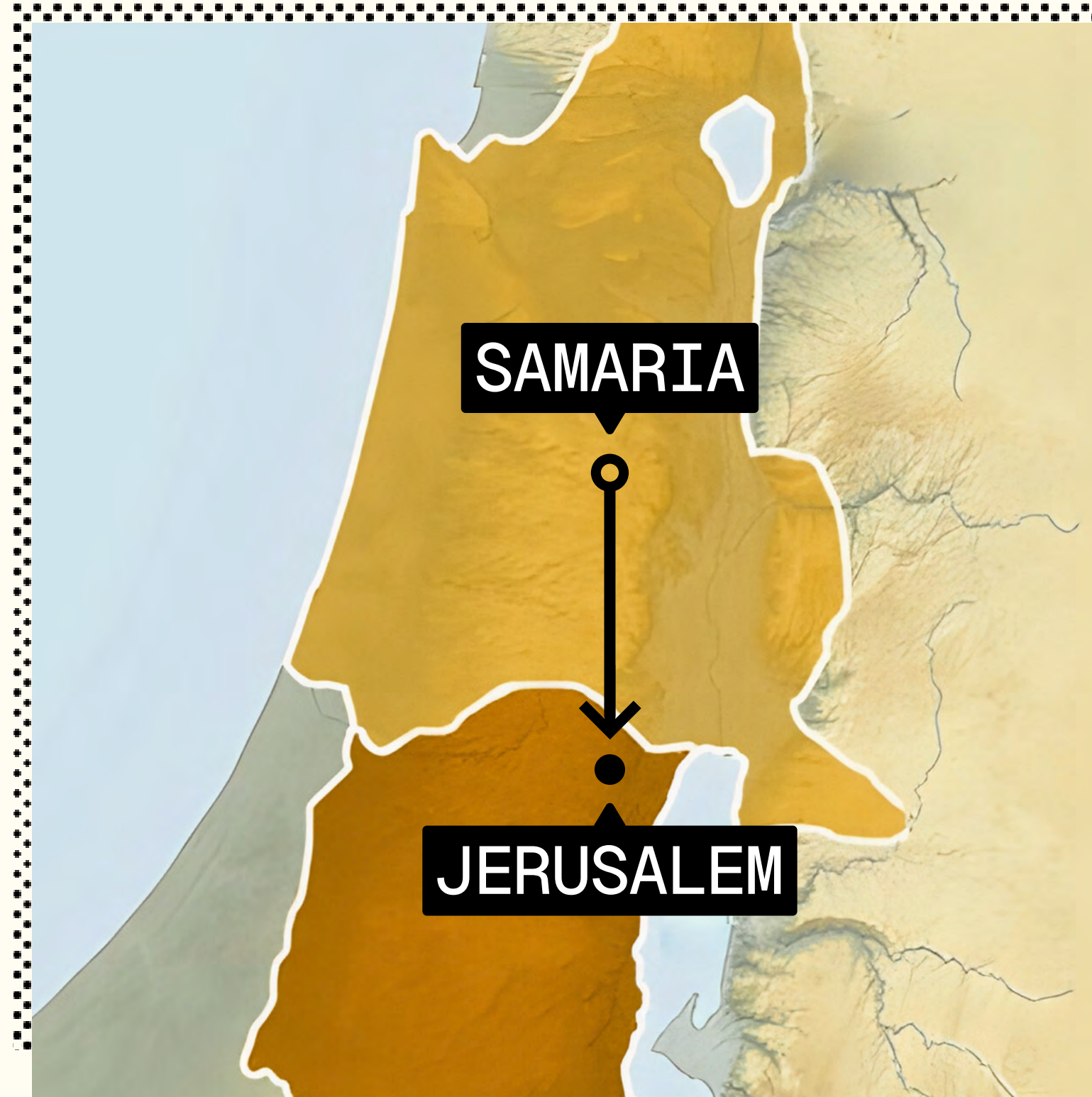

Then Simon answered, “**Pray to the Lord for me** so that nothing you have said may happen to me.”

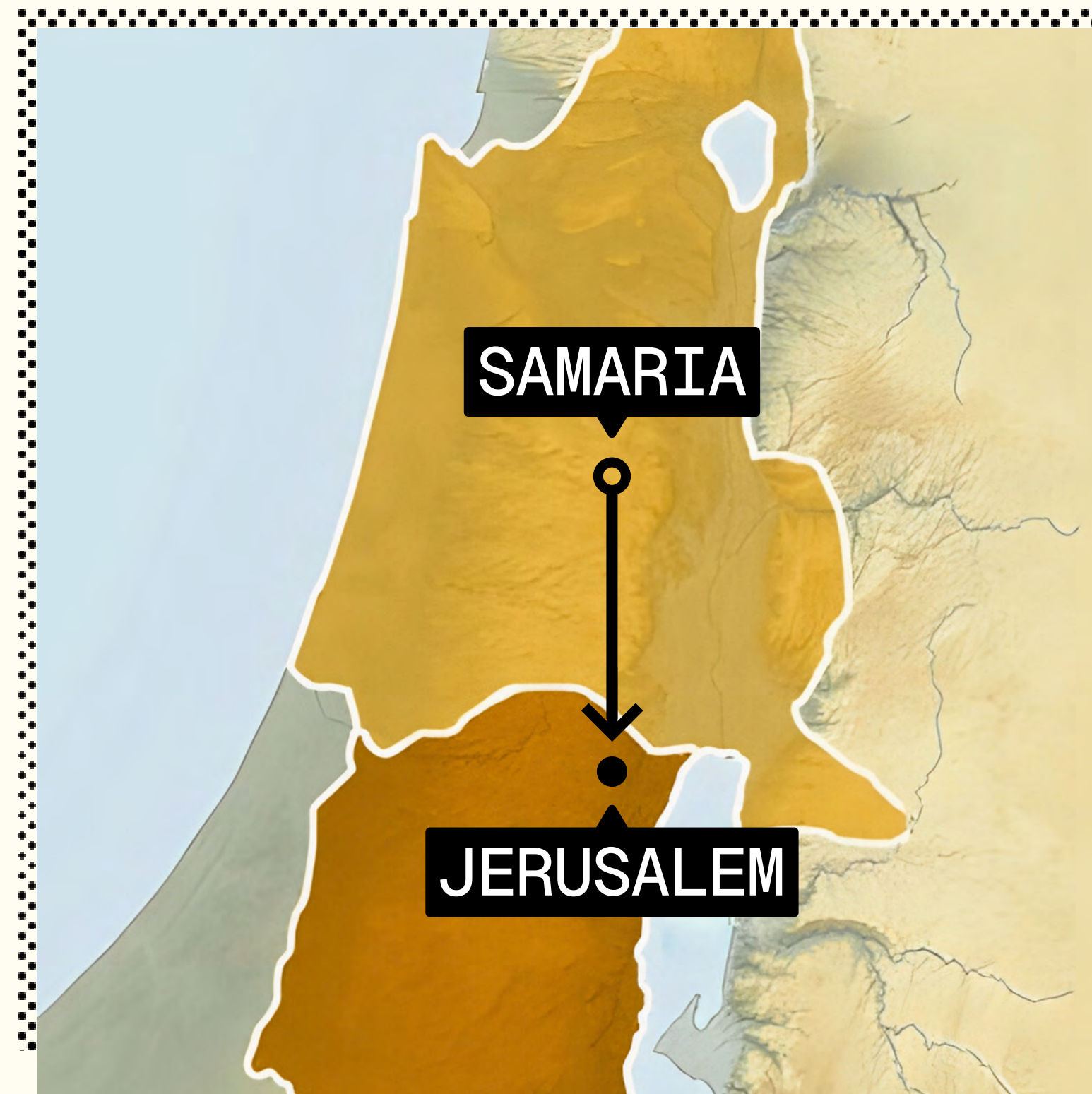

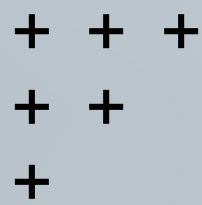
